Distribution of 168.4 million euros from the Contingency Fund

4 May 2012. The Council of Ministers has authorised the use of the Contingency Fund, with funds totalling €168,420,208.26, allocated as follows:

- 167,426,950.17 euros to fund two extraordinary loans in the Ministry of Health, Social Policy and Equality, to pay for two guilty rulings passed by the National Court in 2011. These rulings involve payment of financial compensation for collaboration provided in healthcare assistance to the collaborating entity of the Autonomous Region of Madrid for services provided from July 2004 to December 2008 worth a total of 164,247,421.86 euros and in December 2008 for a total of 3,179,528.31 euros.
- 806.263,68 euros to fund a loan supplement in the Ministry of the Interior to cover costs relating to the provisional execution of a ruling passed by the First Territorial Military Court in 2001 which declared the State to be vicariously liable in accordance with the ruling passed by this Court in 2010 in which a Cadet Ensign Cavalier from the Spanish Civil Guard was convicted of an accidental shooting. The amount corresponds to the annual payments from 2010 to 2012.
- 105,357.42 euros to finance a loan supplement in the Ministry of Finance and Public Administrations to cover compensation costs arising from the National Court ruling on toxic syndrome for which the State has pecuniary liability as a consequence of being ruled vicariously liable.
- 81,636.99 euros to finance a loan supplement in the Ministry of the Interior for costs corresponding to judicial rulings through which eleven health workers from the General Secretariat of Penitentiary Institutions were awarded bonuses for the time dedicated to providing on-duty services at the
