The incorporation of companies through the Enterprise Single Counter Service (VUE) rose by 5.66% in October

 Companies that have been incorporated exclusively by electronic means rose by 59.20%

17 November 2012. In October, 933 new businesses were created through the Enterprise Single Counter Services (VUEs), representing an increase of 5.66% over the same month in 2011 when 883 new companies were incorporated.

Of the total companies created, some 59.20% more were processed by electronic measures (from 250 to 398 new companies) compared to those processed in person, which has fallen by 15.48% compared to October 2011, from 633 to only 535 new businesses.

The data also reflects great interest from entrepreneurs as shown by the data recorded for appointments requesting guidance, which increased by 15.89%, from 3,157 appointment requests in October 2011 to 3,657 in the same month in 2012.

By region, the Canary Islands (252), Madrid (163) and Castilla y León are where most new businesses were created through the Enterprise Single Counter Services (VUEs), while La Rioja (2), the Basque Country (7) and Navarre (13) are the regions with the fewest.

In percentage terms, the highest growth was in Extremadura, with a 180% increase in the creation of new companies, followed by Aragon, with an increase of 107.14%. By contrast, La Rioja (-50%), the Basque Country (-46.15%) and Castilla y León (-26.09%) were the communities with the highest percentage decreases.
