Use of premises in Almeria transferred to ALCER

27 April 2012. The Council of Ministers has agreed to transfer the use of premises located in Plaza del Carmen in Almeria to the Asociación para la Lucha Contra las Enfermedades del Riñón (ALCER-ALMERIA) where psychological therapy sessions, job guidance and leisure and sports activities will be organised for kidney disease sufferers.

The transfer has been made under Act 33/2003 of 3 November on Public Administration Assets, which allows the General State Administration to transfer assets and rights that they do not plan to assign to a public service or use in other ways, to associations declared to be of public benefit.

The Association was declared to be of public benefit by order of the Ministry of the Interior on 9 May 1984, due to the help and care it provides to kidney disease sufferers in the province of Almeria.
