State Representatives in the State-Autonomous Region of Extremadura Joint Committee for Economic and Fiscal Affairs

27 July 2012. The Council of Ministers has approved an Agreement designating the State representatives in the State-Autonomous Region of Extremadura Joint Committee for Economic and Fiscal Affairs, created in the Statutes of Extremadura as a bilateral organ for relations between the State and the Autonomous Region in financial matters.

This committee is responsible for establishing, approving, implementing, updating and monitoring the regional funding system, and channelling fiscal and financial relations between both administrations.

The committee will also consist of an equal number of representatives of the State and the Autonomous Region, and the chairmanship will be rotated between both sides on a yearly basis.

Having agreed with the Autonomous Region that there will be five members for each party represented in the committee, the General State Administration appoints its representatives to the committee as follows:

- Chairman of the General State Administration representatives, the head of the State Secretariat for Public Administrations.
- Committee members. The heads of the following bodies:






- State Secretariat for Budgets and Expenditure.
 - State Secretariat for Finance.
 - General Secretariat for Regional and Local Coordination.
 - Directorate General for the Coordination of Relations with the Autonomous Regions and Local Authorities.
 - Directorate General of the State Tax Authorities.
- The committee secretary will be the head of the Subdirectorate General for Financial Relations with the Autonomous Regions, from the General Secretariat for Regional and Local Coordination.
