



PUBLIC SECTOR BUDGET EXECUTION¹

Up to October 2013, the **consolidated deficit** of the **Central Administration, Autonomous Communities and the Social Security System** was **4.87%** of GDP, excluding the expenditure linked to the restructuring of the banking sector, which amounted to 0.47% of GDP. Breakdown by subsectors:

- The **Central Administration** registered a **deficit of 3.54% of GDP** up to October, excluding the financial assistance.
- The budget outturn of the **Autonomous Communities** was a **deficit of 1.12% of GDP** till October.
- **Up to October, the Social Security System recorded a deficit of 0.21% of GDP**, below the level of the previous month (-0.32% of GDP up to September).

In addition, the latest data of the State budget execution is referred to November. The budget outturn of the **State was 3.96% of GDP up to November**. Excluding interest payments, which registered an increase of 15% (year on year), **the State reduced its primary deficit by 1.5%** compared to the same period of 2012.

The latest data of the **Local Authorities** is referred to the **3Q**, when a surplus of **0.4% of GDP** was recorded. So, the **consolidated deficit of the General Government up to September** amounted to **4.40% of GDP** (excluding financial assistance), well below the deficit target of 6.5% of GDP fixed for the whole year.

From 2013 monthly budgetary information on national accounts basis is also available for **Regions and Social Security** to enhance transparency of public finances at all levels of Government.

1. Central Administration²

- The latest budget outturn information for the Central Administration, which comprises the State and its Public Entities, is referred to October. In addition, the November data execution for the State is also published.
- The Central Administration registered a deficit of €36.3 billion (3.54% of GDP) up to October, excluding the expenditure linked to the restructuring of the banking sector which amounted to 0.47% of GDP.
- Including the financial assistance the outturn of the Central Administration was a deficit of 4.01% of GDP up to October.
- The latest data of the State budget execution corresponds to November, when the State registered a deficit of €40.6 billion, which amounts to 3.96% of GDP. In comparison to the same period of 2012, the deficit in 2013 registered an increase of 0.32 p.p. which is mainly due to the interest payments and the transfers' increase to the Social Security System.

- The State budget outturn recorded in November includes an increase of the interest payments of 15% (year on year). Net of interest payments, the primary deficit (€14.6 billion) has been reduced by 1.5% compared to the same period of 2012.

2. Regional Governments (Autonomous Communities)³

- Since the beginning of 2013, in order to improve budgetary transparency, the Ministry of Finance and Public Administrations publishes monthly budgetary execution data on national accounts basis.
- Up to October, the Autonomous Communities accumulated a deficit of €11.5 billion (1.12% of GDP).
- At regional level, revenues amounted to €114.6 billion (11.2% of GDP), while expenditures recorded €126.1 billion (12.3% of GDP).

3. Social Security System⁴

- 2013 is the first year in which there is a monthly report of the Social Security budget execution on national accounts basis.
- The latest update for the Social Security System data corresponds to October.
- The Social Security System budget outturn in the first 10 months of 2013 ended with a deficit of €2.2 billion (0.21% of GDP), below the level of the previous month (3.3 billion in September, 0.32% of GDP).

- Revenues totalling €126.1 billion, while expenditures amounted to €128.3 billion.

4. Consolidated budget balance of the Central Government, Autonomous Communities and Social Security⁵

- Up to October, the consolidated budget outturn of the Central Government, Autonomous Communities and Social Security is a deficit of €50 billion (4.87% of GDP), excluding the expenditure linked to the restructuring of the banking sector which amounted to €4.8 billion (0.47% of GDP).
- Including the assistance to the banking sector the outturn of the Central Administration, Autonomous Communities and Social Security was a deficit of 5.34% of GDP up to October.
- Revenues amounted to €285.8 billion (27.9% of GDP), while expenditures recorded €340.6 billion (33.2% of GDP).

5. General Government⁶

- According to the new transparency commitments established since 2012, quarterly information of the budgetary outturn of the General Government should be published on national accounts basis. This includes: Central Administration, Regions, Local Authorities and Social Security.
- The latest information published is referred to the third quarter of 2013. Up to September, the consolidated deficit of the Public Administrations was 4.40% of GDP against the deficit target of 6.5% fixed for 2013.
